

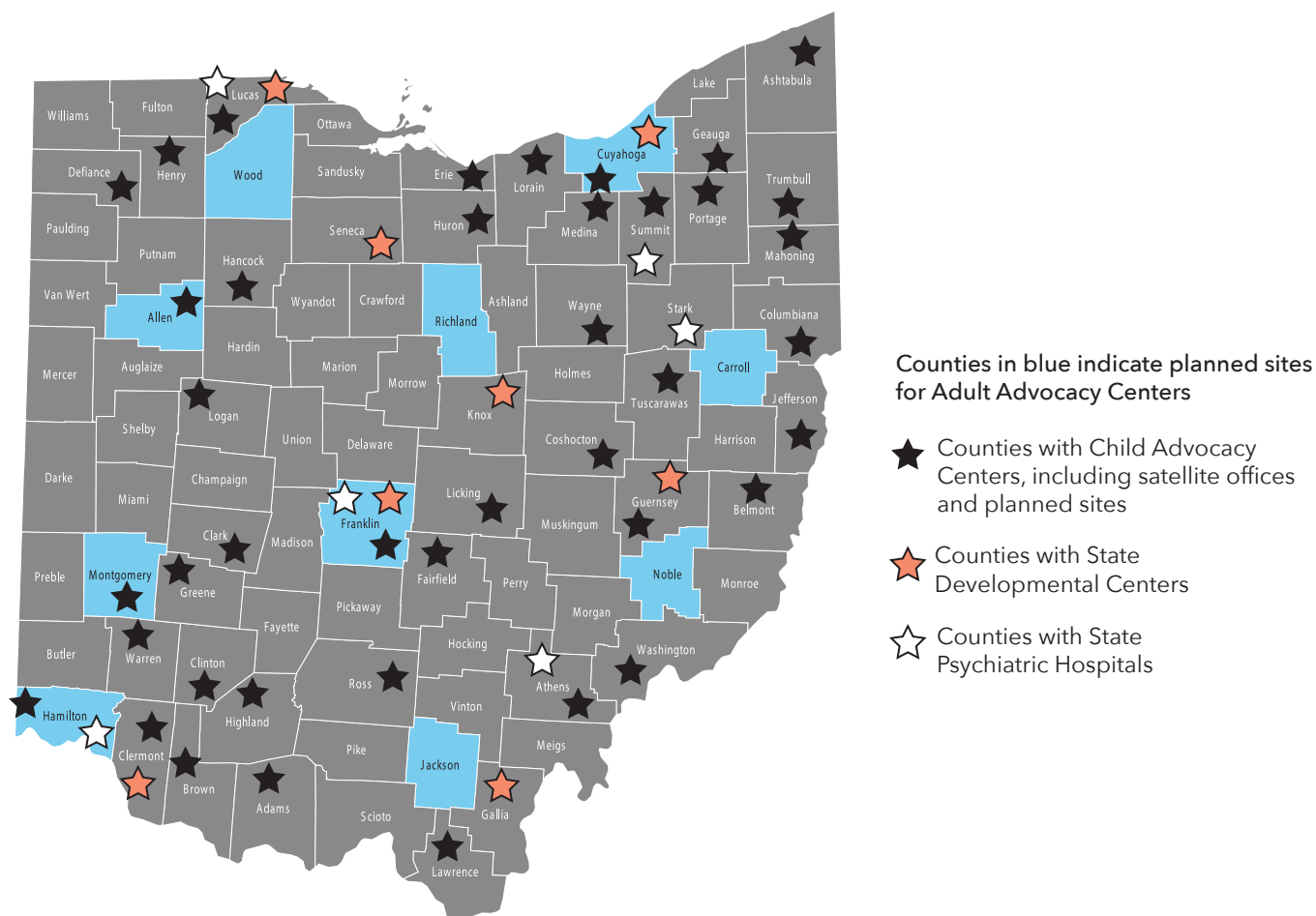


Planned Locations for Adult Advocacy Centers

The AACs will break new ground by incorporating both universal and multi-sensory design into each location, allowing us to serve each client safely and purposefully, according to the needs of their disability. These centers will allow all adults with disabilities to access victim services in an equal, inclusive and accessible way, no matter where they live in the state.

The 10 centers will be located in the following Ohio counties: Allen, Carroll, Cuyahoga, Franklin, Hamilton, Jackson, Montgomery, Noble, Richland and Wood.

These locations were chosen because of their proximity to state-run developmental centers and psychiatric hospitals, as well as existing Child Advocacy Centers. Each center will be unique outside but identical inside.
